SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship is open to any <u>graduating senior</u> in 2018 from a public, private, or home school who is planning to attend a <u>STATE supported</u> <u>PUBLIC</u> West Virginia collage /university and/or State certified school and needs financial assistance to complete his or her studies. The scholarship is only open to persons not currently attending a college and/or university.

INFORMATION REQUIRED AS PART OF THIS APPLICATION: To be considered as a candidate, you must include the following items along with your completed application. Failure to follow the directions may result in disqualification.

- This application form; <u>completely filled out</u>, with the required signatures.
- A copy of your transcript (s) from the school (s) you have attended.
- One letter of recommendation from a high school academic advisor and/or teacher. This is a requirement.
- Additional information required is in Section V and Section VI.

FORMAT: If possible use a word processor or typewriter to answer the questions on this form. Otherwise, print your answers in <u>black</u> ink, do not use a pencil. For attachments, use plain <u>white</u> paper 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" paper with 1-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " margins at the top and left. Use a one (1) inch margins at the bottom and right. Write in <u>black ink</u> or type on one side of the paper only. Line notebook paper is not acceptable .

USE OF INFORMATION: The information submitted in this application is **confidential**. Academic, financial and all other information will be used by the West Virginia Pumpkin Festival Scholarship Committee only and will not be released to any other individual and/or organization. Personal information about the scholarship winners may be used in local publicity and press releases. Winners will be asked and requested to submit a recent photo for publicity.

REQUIREMENTS OF A SCHOLARSHIP WINNER: All winners of this scholarship <u>must</u> be able to attend the West Virginia Pumpkin Festival in the fall to receive a check for the scholarship and special recognition. The winner <u>must show</u> **proof of enrollment** in a <u>public</u> West Virginia State college/university or post secondary career/technology school to the scholarship chairperson.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP AND TERM OF PAYMENT: The amount of the scholarship will be \$2,000.00. The amount paid to the winner(s) can be used at the winner(s) discretion. The scholarship money will be paid at the Pumpkin Festival in the fall following the scholarship award ceremony. Winner(s) need to be present to receive the scholarship funds.

THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES ARE FOR THE WEST VIRGINIA PUMPKIN FESTIVAL SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY:

- All senior students in the State of West Virginia with at least a 2.5 GPA
- All senior students meeting the above with a financial need
- All senior students meeting the above and have completed required community service as required by your county.
- Applicant must be entering a <u>PUBLIC</u> West Virginia college/university and/or certified school.

APPLICATIONS ARE SENT TO EVERY PUBLIC AND PRIVATE HIGH SCHOOL IN THE STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA SELECTION:

- As the applications are received by the West Virginia Pumpkin Festival, they are read by the scholarship chairperson to make sure the student has met the eligibility requirements.
- Copies are made of those eligible and then all identifying marks, such as names and hometowns, are blacked out.
- Applications are given a number to be used in section process.
- After the dateline date the scholarship committee will read all applications and rate them. In case of a tie they will meet and discuss the applications, the chairpersons, due to the fact that they have the names of the applicants, will be in attendance but will not give any input until the four applicants have been selected.
- At this time, the scholarship committee is given the names and locations of the four that they have selected.

NOTIFICATION AND REQUIREMENTS:

- A member of the West Virginia Pumpkin Festival will contact the selected student's guidance counselor and make arrangements to attend the senior awards assembly to present the scholarship winner certificate.
- In the fall the selected students will be required to present to the scholarship chairperson proof of enrollment at a <u>PUBLIC</u> West Virginia college and/or university and attend the West Virginia Pumpkin Festival awards ceremony to receive a check the amount of \$2,000.00.
